As part of the National Curriculum and Physical/Social/Health Education programme of study we plan to deliver sex education lessons to pupils in Years 5 and 6.

Our principle aims are to:

- Ensure children feel safe and secure
- Be objective and ensure children know biological/scientific facts relative to their age range
- Describe the human reproduction cycle
- Define puberty - discuss and explore body changes
- Advise how children can keep themselves safe in a physical and 'online' world
- Focus on loving family relationships
- Educate children about their rights, how they should be considerate and show their respect and be responsible
- Know British Law – what is right and what is wrong

We are confident in encouraging the children to be respectful of the subject and of each other and will use our expertise to ascertain whether specific lesson parts will be taught in same sex or mixed sex groups. An overview of subject content is described in our PSHE curriculum which has been uploaded to our school website.

The school will host an information evening on **Wednesday 6 June from 6pm – 7pm**. At this meeting we will share some video clips for you to observe as parents and summarise the overview of the lessons we plan to deliver to the children. Please note that Y6 parents who joined us for last year's presentation need not attend, if they do not wish, as the content has not fundamentally changed – this is another planned opportunity in the teaching and learning cycle to revise and consolidate facts for Year 6 pupils.
