## KS2 Progress Information

Schools have been given a progress score for reading, writing and maths based on an average of the progress pupils have made from the end of KS1 to the end of KS2, compared to other children nationally who had the same starting points. A score of around zero is deemed to be average. A score above -5 for reading and maths, or above -8 for writing is deemed to be above the National 'floor standard'.

## Note on Progress in Junior Schools from the DfE

We know from national data that pupils at junior schools, on average, have higher attainment scores at the end of KS2 than pupils at other primary schools. However, on average, they also have lower progress scores. This may be for a variety of reasons and should be taken into account when comparing their results to schools which start educating their pupils from the beginning of KS1.
