


Our Explosive World!



Project Outcomes:



In this project the children use the context of ‘our explosive world’ to explore the concept of making a difference. Through geography the children explore the location of earthquakes and volcanoes around the world and begin to discover the impact they have on the lives of people living near them.

‘Making a Difference’ is the name of the game as the children step into someone else’s shoes in order to develop an understanding and ability to empathise with people less fortunate than themselves; and ultimately concluding an answer to the question ‘How can we and why should we make a difference on the lives of people around the world?’ The children work together to organise a fundraising event for a charity of their choice.
