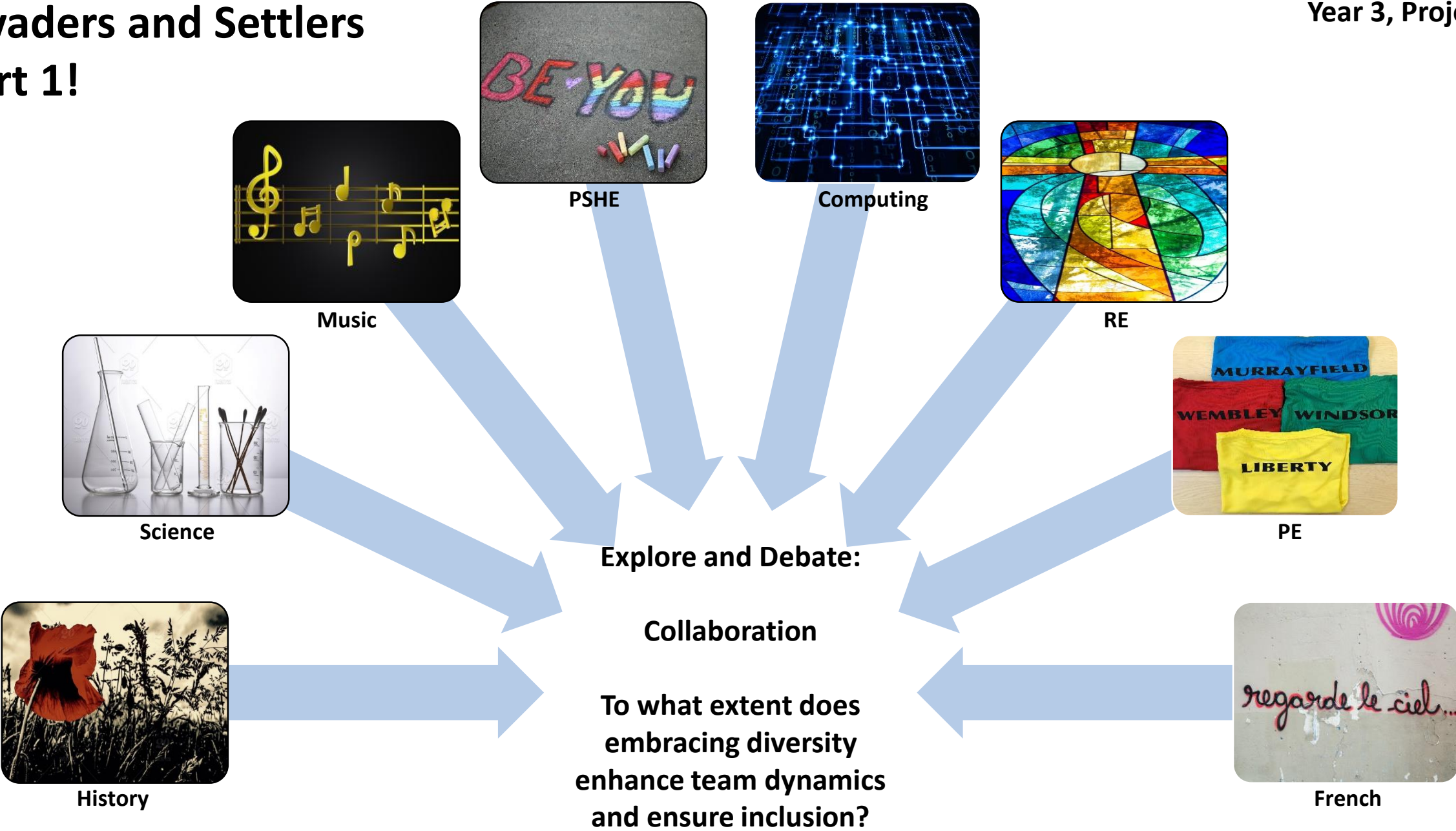


Invaders and Settlers

Project Outcomes:



The summer term sees the invasion of the Romans in year three studying the concept of collaboration.
