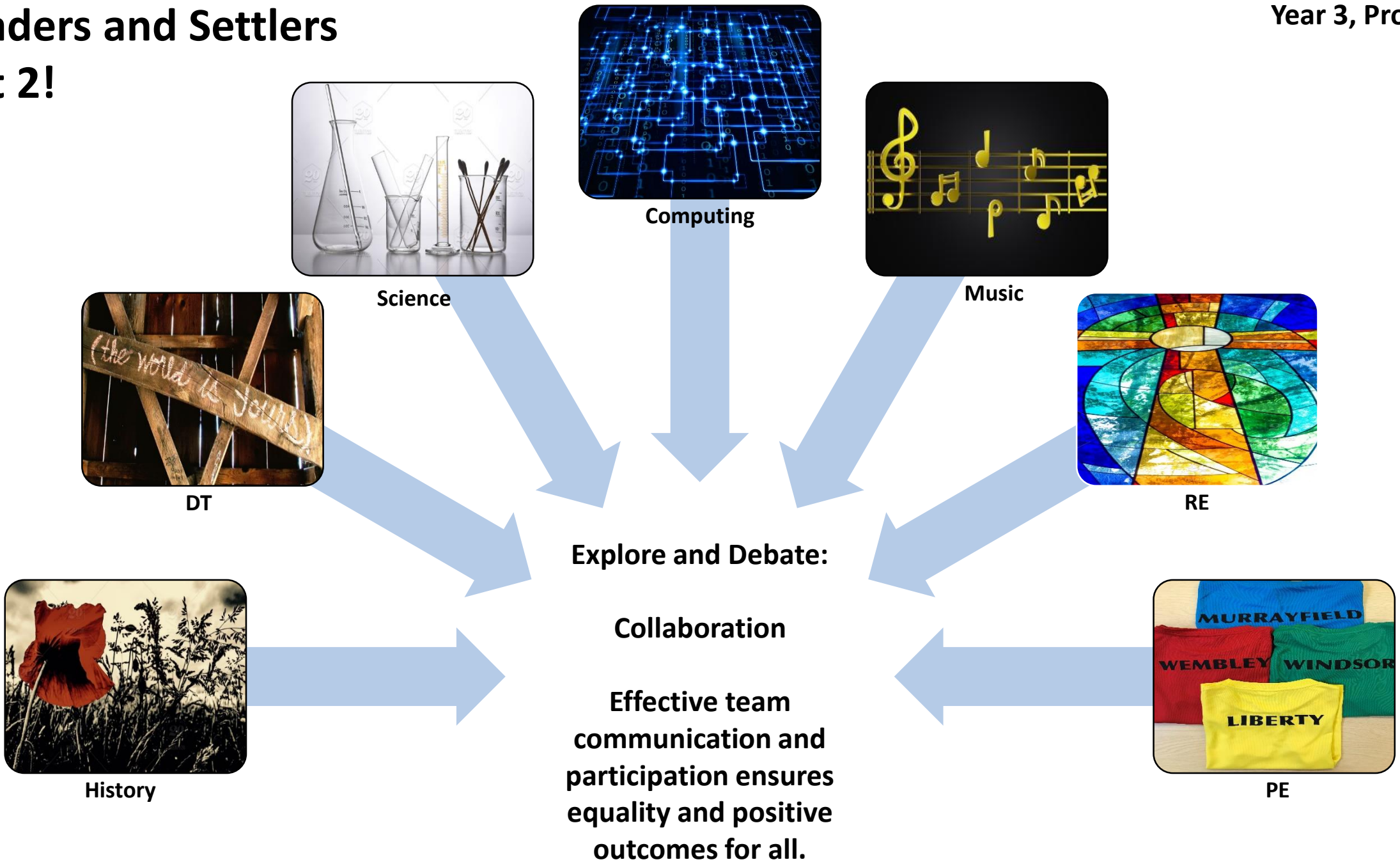


# Invaders and Settlers

## Project Outcomes:



**Through exploring and learning about the Anglo-Saxons the children continue to focus on the concept of collaboration. They extend their learning about the attributes they bring to a team and refine their skills further to explore how effective communication and participation bring positive outcomes. The children continue to develop their EPIC learning value skills whilst also learning about the roles different people can play in a team – leader, scribe, listener, speaker, magpie spy and coach - and use this to analyse what makes effective teamwork.**
