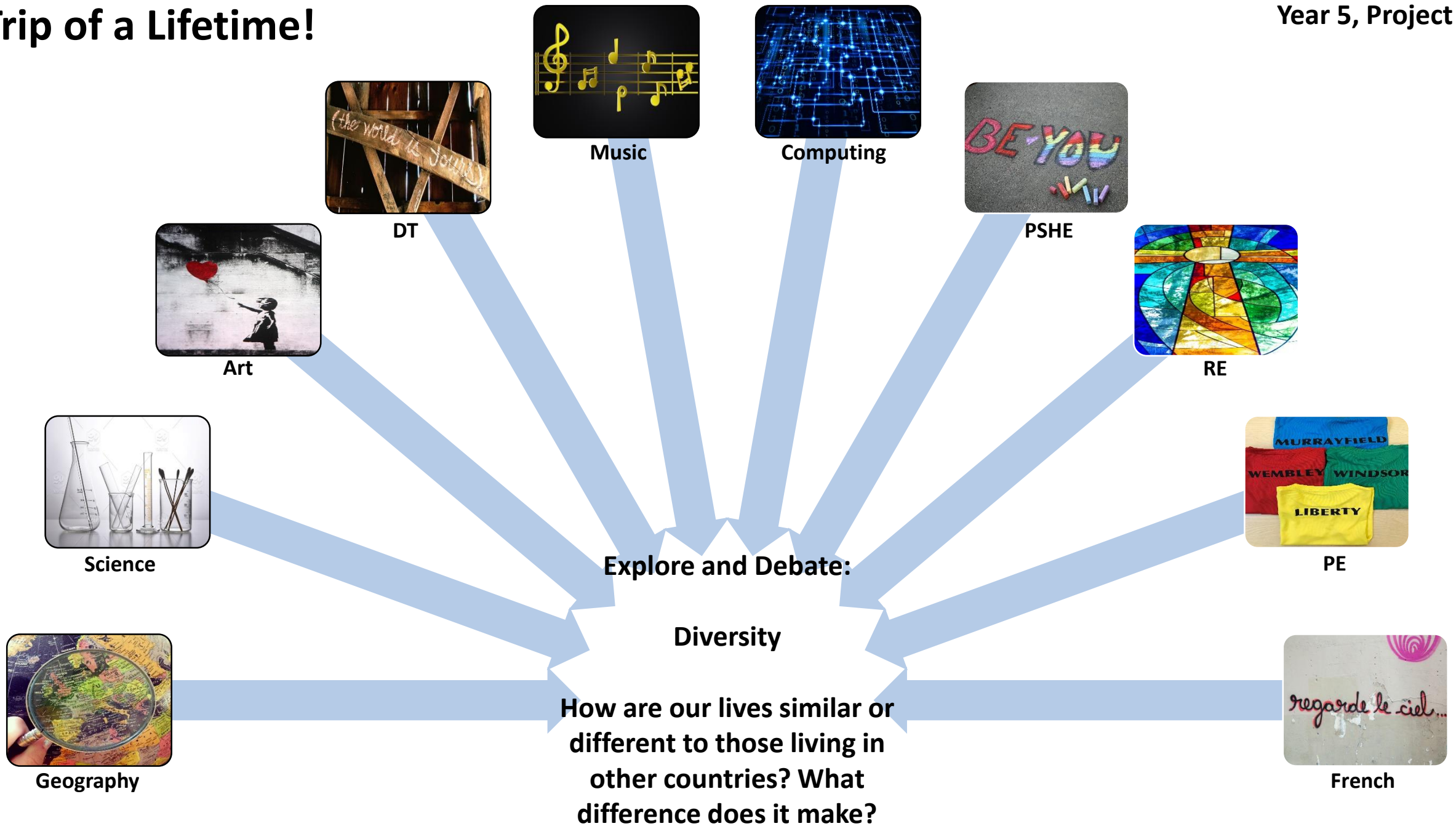


Trip of a Lifetime!



Project Outcomes:



In this project, the children take a ‘trip of a lifetime’ as they travel through North and South America. They begin by exploring and analyse the geographical elements of the countries including climate, vegetation belts and biomes. Whilst on their journey they also scrutinize the diversity of the people and the environments they live in. They make comparisons with their own lives and lives of people in different areas of the country to enable them to decide whether difference really matters.
