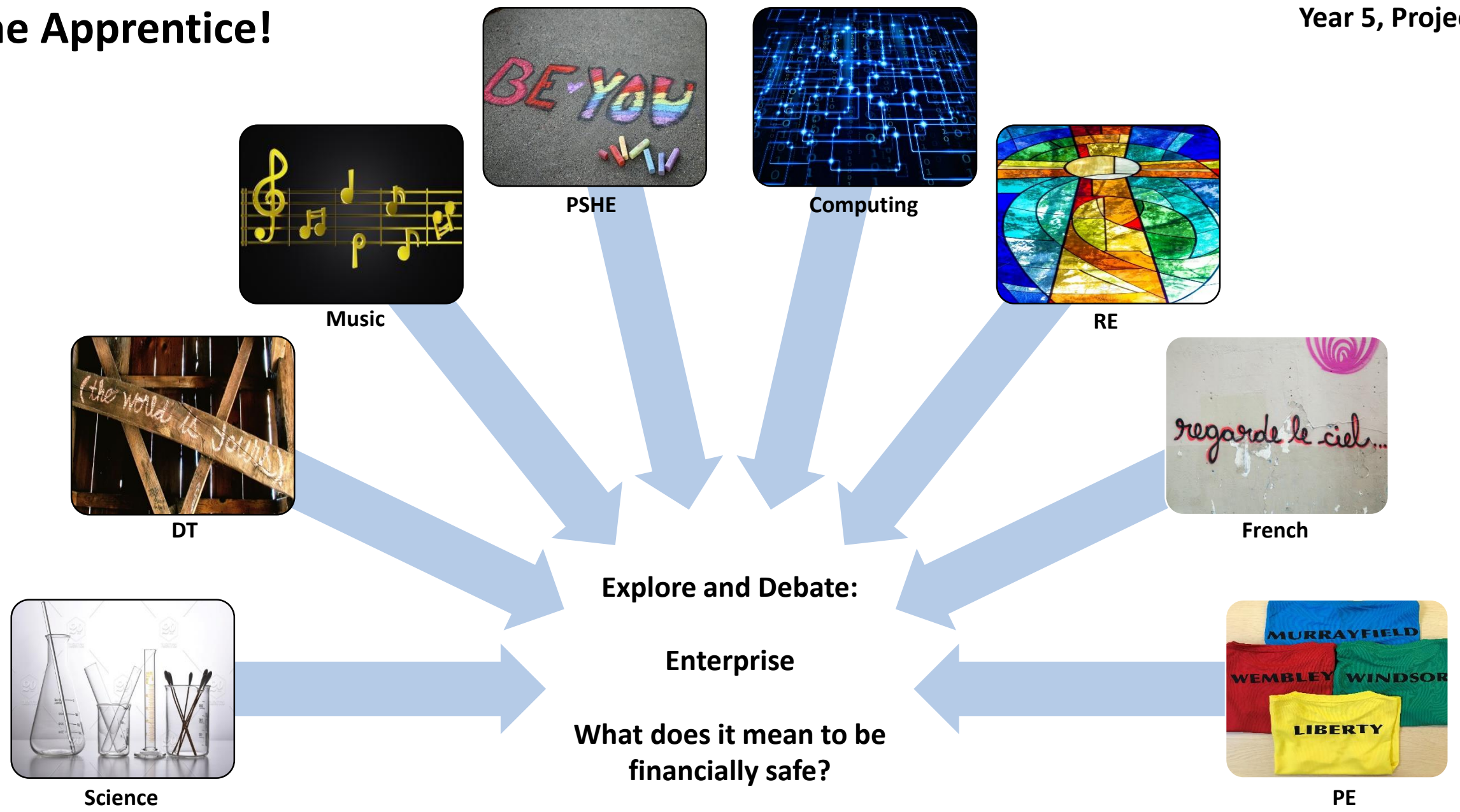


# The Apprentice!



## Project Outcomes:



**The focus of this project is money and what it means to be safe financially. Through their PSHE unit of 'Living in the Wider World' the children learn about money, saving, etc in order that they are equipped with the knowledge and understanding required at the end of KS2. They deliberate about what it means to be financially safe and question how we can ensure all people feel this way.**
