Feedback to children

My teacher will always give me feedback to improve my work. There are different types of feedback my teacher will give me:

1. verbal feedback
2. feedback using the Ranvilles Marking Code
3. written feedback

	A tick will show where I have produced the correct answer OR achieved my learning objective OR achieved my target.
TT	The teacher will initial work to indicate that it has been read.
HP	I have been awarded a House Point either for the effort I have placed into my work or the quality standards I have achieved.
C	A correction is needed. My teacher is holding me to account for skills that I have been taught and can use. I must take responsibility.
SP	A spelling correction is needed. I can use a dictionary or my word bank vocabulary book. I must take responsibility for spelling key words successfully.
P	My punctuation needs to be checked. My teacher will expect me to use the correct punctuation. I will proofread my work to correct it.
G	My grammar need to be checked. My teacher will expect me to use the correct grammar. I will proofread my work to correct it.
VF	My teacher will give me verbal feedback and use this code to show that an adult has talked to me about my learning in that lesson.
PM	When my work has been Peer Marked my friend will put their initials in a circle. This will also give the teacher an opportunity to see if my friend is right too.
	I am focusing on being an epic learner. My teacher will praise me or stamp my work to let me know they are impressed and proud of my effort and achievements.
