It's been another great week learning in class Astute!

In science, we built on our learning of the human skeleton by identifying different types of bones in the human body. We worked as scientists; measuring and recording data to compare bone length. The children loved working in groups to play the game 'build a skeleton'. This required them work collaboratively to identify and acutely draw different bones to create their skeletons.

In maths, the children have been working hard on their partitioning skills to recognise the value of each digit in a number. We then looked at how we can do this in the standard and non-standard way. As the children grew in confidence, they started to think deeper about their maths learning by justifying their answers using 'because'. Keep it up Astute!

I think the highlight this week had to be reading the book 'Into the Forest' by Anthony Browne. The children loved reading this book as a class and looking carefully at the pictures to infer what might happen next in the story. Lots of questioning too and learning new vocabulary – a great end to our days.
