We made the decision for the questionnaire to be anonymous as it is important to us that you feel comfortable in being honest in your feedback. Survey Results

My child is happy in school	93% agree
My child feels safe in school	98% agree
The schools makes sure it's pupils are well behaved	91% agree
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with bullying quickly and effectively	97% (includes children who have not been bullied)
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year	87% agree

We are extremely pleased to see that most children feel happy and safe in school. We aim for every child to feel happy and safe in school and would encourage you to contact the school if you have any concerns at all.

The Ranvilles Junior team feel very passionate about promoting high standards of behaviour across the school and we were pleased to see that 91% of parents who took part in this survey feel that our pupils are well behaved. We continue to encourage all children to have respect and tolerance for others to ensure a happy, safe and secure environment and we have focused on making some improvements.

Curriculum Learning - you said:

The majority agree that the school makes you aware of what your child will learn in the year. However, we would like to improve further

- will continue to write a weekly learning reflection to summarise outcomes. Please do 'like' the review to acknowledge you have read it.

Behaviour – you said:

The vast majority of you said the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved. We are always looking at ways to champion and instill positive behaviours for learning.

...so we:

- self-evaluated as a staff team to improve further how we will share policies and procedures more clearly
- refined our school rules for clarity and are working with governors to update the policy
* *We will share any policy changes with you in a separate focus home.*
- refined individual pupil behaviour plans
- continue to lead whole school assemblies to promote positive expectations
- engaged in mental health training to support pupils
- will continue to send 'Milestone' maps home as reports
- will continue to reward and value our children who make fantastic choices
