Week Beginning:

It's been another great week learning in class Radiant!

In maths, the children have been working hard on their partitioning skills to recognise the value of each digit in a two digit number. We then looked at how we can do this in the standard and non-standard way. As the children grew in confidence, they started to think deeper about their maths learning by justifying their answers using 'because'. We finished the week tackling number lines. The children could confidently step count but found it tricky when having to work out what the steps were. Thankfully, they all showed excellent perseverance skills and are now much more confident. Now that this knowledge is secure we will be moving on and tackling 3 digit numbers next week.

In science, we built on our learning of the human skeleton by identifying different types of bones in the human body. Great fun was had drawing round our shorter members of the class to create a human size body that we could then place our initial thoughts onto. The children recalled their bone knowledge and noted it down. We then sunk our teeth into learning to find out the truth before correcting our diagrams. Fun fact: Did you know that half of your body's bones are in your hands and feet!
