Another week comes to and end and I have been impressed with the children's attitude towards their learning. We are still recapping over expectations of the children after the summer break but they are working hard to improve each and every day.

The children have been focused on writing their non-chronological reports this week having previously found their facts. They have focused on writing in the correct style and creating different sections for appearance, habitat and diet. Some have even included a fun facts section! Our focus continued on number and place value this week with the children exploring adding 1, 10, 100 and 1000 or taking away these amounts. We have used practical resources to understand how to exchange when we don't have the necessary amount and it has been great to see the children using practical resources to help them access the tasks independently.

Our curriculum work continues with the children practising their passing skills in Basketball, learning about Google Docs in Computing and continuing to explore the differences between children in historical times compared to now. We have also set up a science experiment for Monday today where eggs have been placed in water, vinegar and coke. On Monday, we will look at the strength of different toothbrushes to determine which is best for cleaning our own teeth.
