As we reflect on another exciting week in our classroom, it's evident that a captivating Ancient Greek theme has shaped our learning adventures. In our history lesson we researched some of the more well-known gods and thought a little about the importance of these figures to the daily lives of people. Building on this historical exploration, in our English lessons each child selected a god and described them, putting them into a scene that matched our history findings.

In mathematics, we have focussed on factors, multiples, square and prime numbers, alongside a more efficient method for multiplication (The formal method of short multiplication.) The children have done well, but consistent times table practice at home would really support them with this unit of work and enable them to be more accurate in their calculations.
