Weekly Learning Reflections

In Maths we have continued to explore addition and subtraction with the children focusing on formal methods of calculation. Throughout the rest of the week, the children have explored modern day versions of the "Good Samaritan" story and created their own storyboards about these versions. They have also looked at a range of emotions through PSHE and thought about how people behave when they are feeling certain ways.
