Another week complete and we have continued to focus on being respectful communicators and treating everyone equally. It has been great to see more children willing to work with newer pairs and some have shown excellent co-operation and collaboration skills as a result of this.

Our Ranvilles reporters have continued their hard-work in English, focusing on practising writing correctly punctuated direct speech to ensure quotes included in their newspaper are used correctly. They have had great fun interviewing their friends, finding out how they felt and learning about how different punctuation can lead to differences in how things are said. We have begun writing our introductions, focusing on summarising the key information and thinking of different ways to engage the reader.

In Maths, our focus has moved onto multiplication and division with us exploring and learning how to use the grid method accurately. The children have shown great understanding of this and their accuracy has been very impressive. As we move forwards with this, it will test the times table knowledge and their ability to recall times table facts. There has been some excellent presentation in their Maths books as well and it has been great to see the children focusing on this to present their work as best as possible.

Our attention has turned to the dangers facing the rainforest in the curriculum and we have begun researching ways in which we can help protect them. We have also continued to use Scratch to create a quiz, practised our dribbling and passing skills in football and have begun to explore circuits in science. The children have shown good attitudes across these subjects and are working hard to apply themselves to all of their learning.
