Last Friday a visitor arrived in our classroom as Edwardo the Elf arrived with Christmas decorations and an advent calendar full of books. Great delight is had coming in the classroom to see where the mischievous elf is hiding. The children are also loving the short, christmasy stories at the end of the day. We have been reading them and making Christmas cards for the local care home for the last 10 minutes of the day and it has been lovely.

In English this week we have been focusing on developing speech writing skills using the correct punctuation. 'ICAPI' has been the code to help us remember this – challenge your child to see if they remember what it means. On Wednesday we role played an alternative ending to 'The Elves and the Shoemaker' as a plan for our narrative writing before transferring this into writing on Thursday. From what I have read so far, the children have done brilliantly and today's editing lesson will have only improved their pieces.

Our Big Problem in maths saw us sailing the seven seas as we tackled a treasure hunt. The children faced a range of fraction problems but they used their fraction skills brilliantly, as well as applying the explanation skills we have been working on in our learning over the past couple of weeks. This has been a tricky task as not only do you need to know the answer, you need to explain the mathematical thinking behind it too. I have been super impressed with the children's efforts with this.

I am very proud of the Year 3 pupils today as they performed to the school. The children acted, sung and danced beautifully so the staff and other pupils were very impressed. We can't wait for you to see it next week.
