They have continued to work hard this week and have tried to showcase the best of themselves through their independent application of their learning so far. We have used this week to develop children's independence and assess their understanding so that we can tailor their learning for Spring Term effectively.

Across the curriculum, the children have continued to work hard and develop their understanding of numerous areas. As the week began, they explored more about the dangers to the rainforest and what we can do to help protect it. They are working in groups to create a persuasive argument to present to the class about why it is important and how we can help. As well as this, they continued working on their musical compositions. These are using body percussion to represent the lower layers of the rainforest before we add tuned percussion to represent the emergent and canopy layers.

Next week, these will be painted before washing the glue out to create an artistic effect. Our Science and DT have come together this week as the children have started to evaluate different torch designs in preparation for designing and creating their own.
