I have been truly wowed by the children's creativity in English this week. We have been developing our sentence skills by using time, place and cause conjunctions to add further detail to descriptive sentences. Razvani's Grotto was the focal point of our writing so the children were able to explain the characters and rooms appearance and movement which they did beautifully. A mini story write today showcased all their efforts and I am very proud of all of them! On top of this we have been using our Ranvilles Reading Masters to become the Master Reporter. Like him, the children used specific details to share what is happening in a text to great effect.

Measure has been the theme of the week in maths however, we have had a big focus on problem solving and reasoning skills throughout this unit. Great care has been taken to decode questions to see what it specifically asking them to do before explaining their thinking as well as finding the answer. A tricky task for all but perseverance was applied and solutions were successfully found. The children finished the unit today with the 'big measure scavenger hunt' which saw them romancing the playground to find specific items to estimate length or weight. This was followed by measuring to see if their predications were correct. The children also challenged themselves with converting, ordering and problem solving tasks.

Another opportunity for creativity arose in French on Thursday as the children mimicked the style of Henri Matisse to create abstract images of animals. However, they had to ask their partner to go and collect the shapes they needed in French so specificity was needed to pin point the size and colour that they wanted. We also learnt about cognate and near cognate due to some animal names being so similar in both French and English.
