It's the end of our first full week back and what a busy week it feels like it's been! children have covered all manner of subjects in their learning this week and it is great to see them working hard and challenging themselves to be the best they can be. Our description has been developing this week as we have looked at fronted adverbials and different ways of constructing sentences to show the reader what is happening rather than tell. Our time unit in Maths has drawn to a close as the children have spent the week converting between different units of time and then solving problems related to their time learning.
