

Extract from SEN Information Report 2023-24 Ranvilles Junior School

SEND Transition

The school has a transition programme with local infant and secondary schools to ensure that children are prepared for the next phase in their school life.

Year 2 children visit Ranvilles Junior School in the Summer Term and are given the opportunity to meet their new teacher and get used to their new surroundings. Year 2 and Year 3 class teachers meet to discuss the children, including children with special educational needs. The SENDCo also meets infant school staff to transfer information about key children and attend TPA meetings and Annual Review meetings. Year 2 parents are invited to visit the school and have the opportunity to talk to class teachers and members of the Senior Leadership Team.

Year 6 teachers meet with secondary school staff to transfer records and also discuss individual needs. The SENDCo arranges TPA meetings for individual children to which the parents are invited and encouraged to contribute their views and ask questions to help their child make a smooth transition.

Children are supported by making additional visits to their new school to help them make adjustments. Any children who join the school other than at the start of the academic year are supported by a buddy to help them to settle quickly. The SENDCo will contact previous schools to ensure that records are transferred and the child's needs are discussed in more detail.
