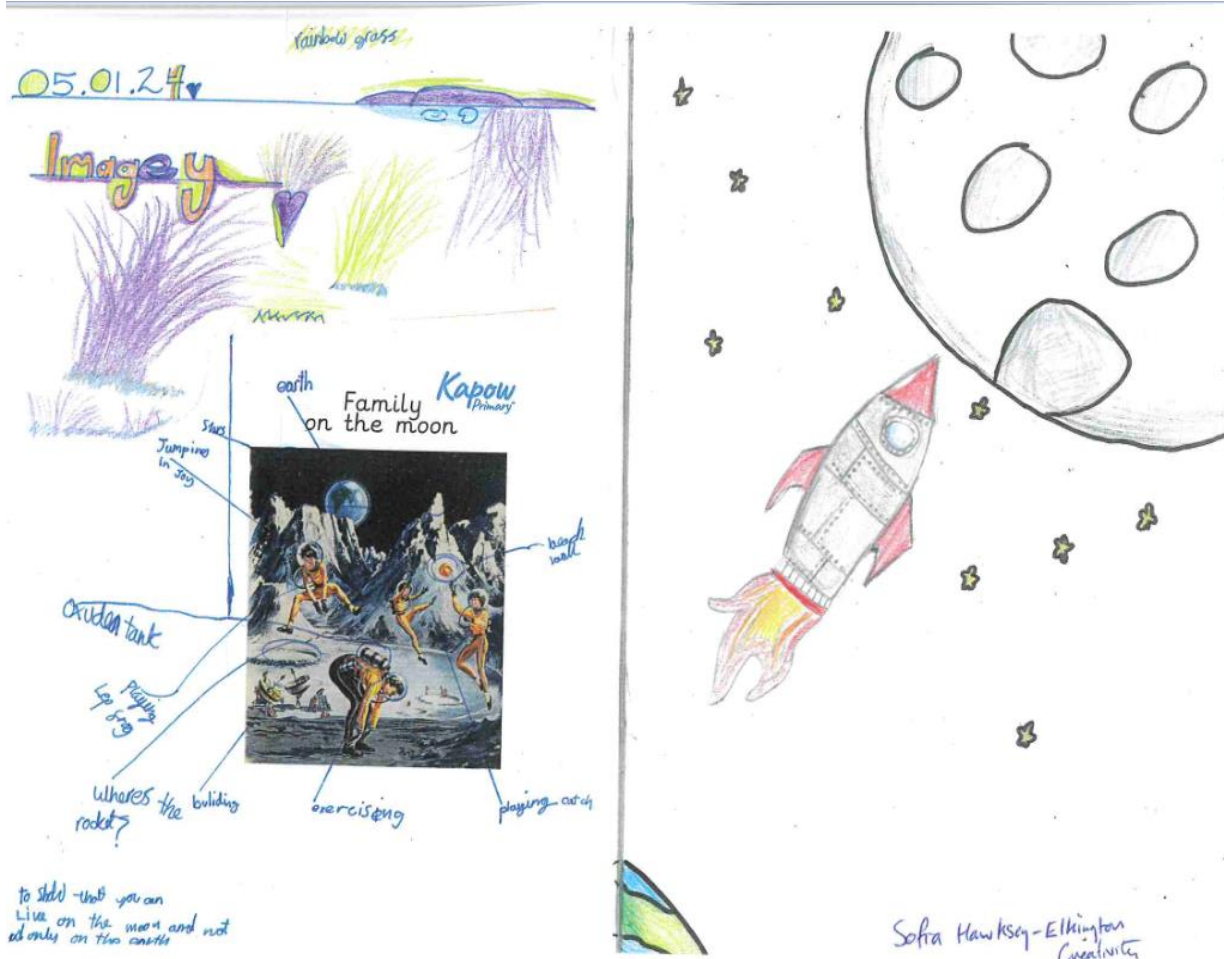
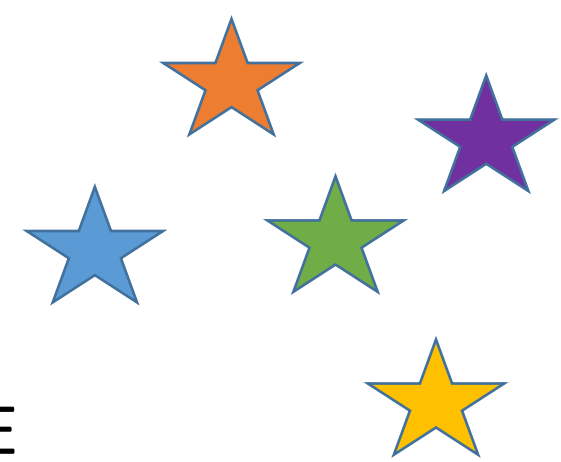
It was a bad trip, I'll tell you all about it! We started at the King's palace. He gave us arrows and spears. We got on

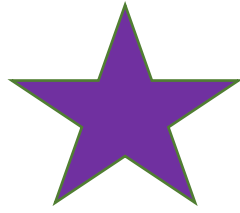
