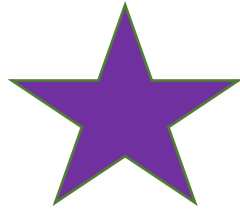

I found that the closer I was to the source the louder it was as the vibrations were closer together which I liked.

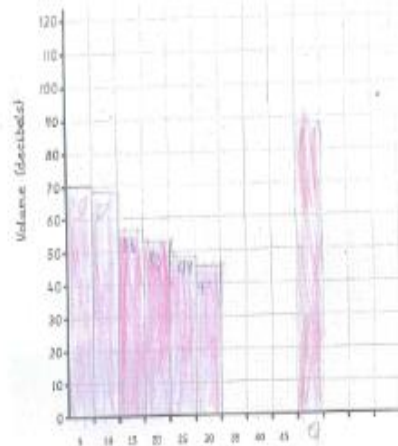

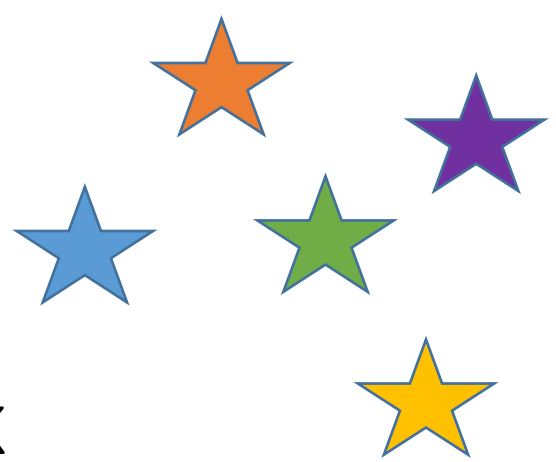

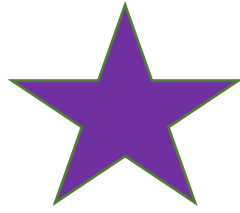
