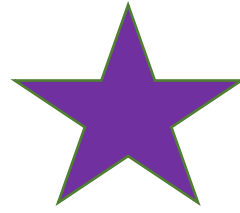
So we said our good byes and went back to our trenches I hoped Otto would survive and ~~find~~ ^{find the} chocolate in his pocket
