Week Beginning:

Happy Friday 😊

Our second week of the year has seen the children continue to settle into life at Junior School.

English has seen the children practising their prediction skills based on evidence collected from our class story 'After the Fall – How Humpty Dumpty got back up again' by Dan Santat as well as verbally inferring the information that the text suggests but doesn't say. Later in the week we looked at sentence types and developed expanded noun phrases ready to use in their writing as this unit progresses.

Number and place value has been our focus in maths so children have been demonstrating their understanding of number throughout the week. It has been excellent to see the children challenge themselves to use correct mathematical language and resources when partitioning 2 and 3 digit numbers and persevering when solving problems.

Have you ever considered what humans would be like if they didn't have a skeleton? This was a key question in our Science lesson on Monday as the children discovered that not all animals have them. We explored the difference between endo and exo skeletons and how these differ between vertebrates and invertebrate animals before categorising based on these features.

On top of this we have had 2 PE sessions where the children developed basic PE skills and Mrs Mori was blown away with the impressive artist we appear to have across Year 3 on Thursday. Mrs Lewis/Wigmore were both singing the children praises after their first music lesson too.#
