Week Beginning:

Happy Friday. 😊

Can you believe that we have completed our first week of Autumn 2 already? It has flown by.

Maths saw us tackle another 'Big Problem' but this time the children had to use all of their measure skills to help them solve Farmer Fred's animal enclosure issue. Throughout the week we have learnt how to accurately calculate the perimeter of 2D shapes by using mental maths skills. Fantastic perseverance was shown as they not only solved tricky problems but applied their explanation and reasoning skills brilliantly.

A new half term sees a new Science unit meaning we are looking at Forces and Magnets. The children loved science this week as we developed an understanding of contact forces. This was a very practical lesson which saw the children exploring and classifying forces as a push, pull or a twist. They then applied their 'working scientifically' skills by using arrows and scientific vocabulary to label diagrams to show the direction of the force.

The start of the week saw us focusing on trees as we looked at symbolism in religion. The children were excellent at considering the different reasons that a tree might be used in every day life and applied these to their understanding of 'The Garden of Eden' chapter from the Bible. I was very impressed with their maturity as they listened to, built upon and challenged one another's views.
