English this week has seen us finish a narrative based on the story 'Du Iz Tak' by Carson Ellis. The children utilised their plans alongside their descriptive language and conjunction skills to re tell the story. I was very impressed with their advanced vocabulary when describing the scenes and use of speech to show communication between the bugs.

Art continued with our Stone, Bronze and Iron age theme as the children discovered cave paintings. After an initial review of their opinions the children used images of British wildlife to create simple sketches. They used their previous learning to build up shape and then limited detail to replicate the ancient style of art.
