Week Beginning: 18 November 2024

Another week complete and the children have continued to work hard and explore new learning. We have had an eventful week in school with an RE day, our 'break-in' and so much more!

On Monday, the children spent the day looking at the differences of signs and symbols and the importance symbols play in people's lives. They applied this learning to explore symbols important to them and discussed how they became important.

Following this, the children were greeted on Tuesday by ransacked classrooms. They spent time interviewing Mr Williams and exploring the scene whilst discussing their thoughts and emotions. This will all lead into the children writing a newspaper report about the event.

Multiplication has become the focus of Maths with children exploring multiplying by 10 and 100 before moving onto using the grid method. It has been great to see counters and dienes being used and the children developing their accuracy throughout the week.

In the afternoons, the children have continued to practise their coding skills, developing a quiz on Scratch. They have also investigated the differences between conductors and insulators before practising balances and partner balances in gymnastics. Well done Victory, you've had a great week!
