Another busy week has come to an end and the children have worked hard!

Maths this week has seen us continue to tackle the tricky world of Fractions. The children can confidently use the numerator and denominator to identify the fraction and are now applying that knowledge to compare and order. We have also explored fractions as a whole as well as those over a whole amount in both mixed and improper fraction forms.

Our letter writing unit has continued in English as the children have developed their paragraph writing skills. Through their independent writing they have identified themed paragraphs that build information throughout. A tricky task that they have shown excellent perseverance to overcome.

We have been enjoying our multiple French lessons this week as we have been learning how to describe 2D shapes. The children know different colours, sizes and shape names to be able to spot and say full descriptive phrases. They have even mastered the knack of changing the word order to the French style. For example, un petit carré bleu = a small blue square. This was practised through a team work challenge that used shapes to create abstract art, the catch being, they could only communicate in French!
