Week Beginning:

Happy Friday 😊

Our creativity has shone this week as we have mapped out our origin stories for Razvani the fire fiend. The children initially generated the story line before acting out in small groups. Next, they took photos to create a story board and added detail and vocabulary that will be useful when writing. Today we began our long write to tell their interesting stories. The initial paragraphs written have used our recent learning well as expanded noun phrases for description and time, place and causal conjunctions to extend ideas have allowed the children to add in specific details making their reader paint a picture of what is happening. We will finish these next week.

In maths, we have started our new unit on geometry and have been looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We quickly became familiar of the properties of both 3D and 2D shape, such as learning about faces, vertices and edges. This helped us to recognise each shape and also construct them using Polydron and other modelling materials. Next week, we shall be learning about sizes of angles and different types of line so that we can draw shape confidently and accurately.

Volcanoes have continued to be the theme in our Geography lessons as the children have discovered different types and states of the mighty mountains. Exploration of the terms active, dormant and extinct allowed the children to see volcanoes in different parts of their lives before exploring the feature and structures of composite and shield volcanoes. We have finished the week considering the positives and negatives of living near a volcano and the children expressed a wide range of interesting views with maturity and clarity of their understanding.
