Continuing to explore poetry, the children have written their own creation about an animal, thinking up powerful similes and exploring the beat and rhythm to make their poem flow. The week culminated in some children performing their poems to the class and it was great to see the expression and intonation come across to engage the audience.

Fractions have remained our focus in Maths with the children exploring equivalent fractions this week. We have used bar models and number lines to help us with this and the children have shown great determination and exploration skills to find possible equivalent fractions and explore why they are the same.

Throughout the week, the children have taken part in a fair-trade challenge, exploring what makes trade fair and how it relates to the food we buy in the supermarket. They have also investigated what type of material sound travels through best, testing solids, liquids and gases and many were surprised by the results. Accuracy was the focus of golf this week with the children working hard to control where the ball lands whilst we finished the week with a mindful yoga session.
